

**Sermon Application/Discussion Questions – 11/05/2017**  
**Sunday Message: Warren – Romans 7:13-25**  
**Sanctified: The Enemy Within**

1. How do you recognize and deal with the reality of indwelling sin in your life?
2. In what ways do you tend to respond when the reality of sin is revealed in you? Do you tend to be surprised, discouraged, defensive, or do you feel rescued, humbled, and agreeable? Or, can you simply be indifferent at times? In what ways do you treat sin casually, or minimize it?
3. As Christians, sin no longer has dominion over us because Jesus defeated sin on the cross and we are set free in Christ. Considering this truth, what Scriptures come to mind that help your perspective when sin is exposed in your life? How does your union with Christ encourage and strengthen you in your battle against sin?
4. In the message, Martyn Lloyd Jones was quoted as saying, “You and I must never look at any sin in our past life (or current life) in any way except that which leads us to praise God and magnify His grace in Christ Jesus.” When you sin, what do you think your response to sin could look like if you were to live out the central truth of this quote?
