

**Sermon Application/Discussion Questions – 12/03/2017**  
**Sunday Message: Warren – Exodus 3:1-8**  
**Advent: Delivered**

1. There is a consistent theme in the Bible where before there is a commission from God, he first provides a revelation. In Exodus 3, God reveals himself to Moses and then commissions him to a task. Share a time when God personally revealed himself to you and out of that revelation, you received a clear directive from the Lord.
2. Has there ever been a time you've struggled to understand and perceive how God was going about something in your life? When considering God's sovereign work in life situations and trials, do you tend to have a short-term or a long-term view? Looking back, how has God changed your story for the better in ways that you would not have chosen at the time?
3. Of all our needs, the greatest is to be delivered from our sin and God's wrath. Jesus, by his shed blood and death on the cross, has provided the only truly sufficient means to deliver us. Knowing this, are there times when you still attempt to participate in your own deliverance? If so, why? What does that activity look like when you do it? What are specific ways that you need to better trust in Jesus' deliverance, rather than your own?
