God's Power in Our Weakness: Surprising Strength for Suffering Souls

1. A clay jar is easily broken and is only a temporary storage place. Although we are fragile, and our lives are transient like jars, we as Christians carry the gospel message of Jesus Christ. The ability to survive being crushed or struck down or in despair due to hardship is not based on our strength but on the power of the Holy Spirit within us. In what ways have your hardships and weaknesses served as opportunities to rely on and experience God's power?
2. Share an example of how you're growing spiritually during your momentary struggles. How is God working in you and demonstrating the power of the gospel through you?
3. How might your example of trusting God in weakness and through your hardships help someone else experience the grace of the gospel? How would you explain to someone else how your troubles in this world are "light and momentary" when compared to eternity?
