Title: “It’s Time”

Text: 1 Peter 4:1-6

Main Points:

1. Three Gospel Commitments (verses 1-3)
 - a. Settle with suffering.
 - b. Passions for the past.
 - c. Willing God’s will.
2. Two Personal Costs (verse 4)
 - a. They are surprised at you.
 - b. They malign you.
3. One Final Accounting (verses 5-6)

Application Questions:

1. What do you do to daily prepare for and arm yourself in your fight against sin?
2. What have you settled for in living an “unchecked” life? What would accountability look like for you?
3. Why is it important for a Christian to live differently from the world?
4. Do you come across to others as different because you’re willing to suffer for righteousness as a Christian? What does this look like?
5. Has someone ever been surprised or maligned you when you did not participate in a certain sinful or worldly practice? If so, how does verse 5 help you to remain steadfast in pursuing righteousness when you’re up against temptation?
6. Consider some names of people you can pray for and share the hope of Christ with so that they too can rightly understand how to really live and what to live for.
