Sunday Message: Andrew Kalvelage – 2 Corinthians 6:1-13
God's Power in Our Weakness: The Gospel Effect

1. What benefits of the gospel of Jesus Christ are currently impacting you and your life? How are you personally being affected and changed as you apply gospel truths?
2. In 2 Corinthians 6:1, the apostle Paul appeals to the church in Corinth to not receive the gospel in vain. When considering what Paul means, it seems that he is making an appeal that their response to the gospel and its benefits should have an effect, bearing the fruit of faith and godly conduct, regardless of their circumstances. Considering your own situations in life—whether they are good or bad—how are you making the most of opportunities to humbly reflect a cross-centered life that pleases the Lord? Share an experience of how your speech or actions served to commend the gospel and demonstrated the love of Christ to others.
3. Paul illustrates how godly character traits serve as effective weapons of righteousness. Through the empowerment of the Holy Spirit, what godly traits are most evident in your character? What godly traits are not as evident? Pray that the gospel will have a deeper effect and impact on your life and in our conduct.
