Sunday Message: Andrew Kalvelage – 2 Corinthians 6:14-7:1
God’s Power in Our Weakness: Relational Holiness

1. How do you understand what it means to be “unequally yoked” (verse 14) with unbelievers whom you relate with in family contexts, at school, at work or in any other activities where you associate with others? Do you discern any relationship or association where you may be unequally yoked?
2. In what ways might an unbeliever perceive that you are living holy life set apart for God and His purposes? How evident to others is the reality of your close relationship with the Lord, that you spend time with Him, belong to Him, and have come to share—as Andrew put it, His “pace and purpose” as you are yoked with Him?
3. What motivates you to live a life of holiness? In the end, do you think you tend to be more inclined to try and turn from sin out of fear and shame of consequences, or from a desire for the good, relational fruits of being yoked with Christ?
