God's Power In Our Weakness: Self-Spending for Sinful Souls

1. How do you tend to deal with sinful offenses against you when fellow Christians are involved?
2. How do you usually respond when you encounter sinful situations in the church? What tends to become your goal? Do you tend to:
 - Demand to be understood or appreciated in the conflict
 - Strive to “win” the argument or case for yourself or others, or have your perspective vindicated
 - Retain your hurt, but then avoid conflict over the grievance, hoping it will just go away or somehow resolve itself
3. How is God growing you to become more Christ-like during your conflicts and disagreements with other Christians?
4. Knowing that Christian discipleship is a call to spend ourselves for others because of the richness of our forgiveness in the Lord, in what ways has this message encouraged you to be diligent in pouring out your life for fellow sinners—your brothers and sisters in Christ?
