Proverbs 12:15

1. Wise counsel is a way that God provides, protects, and cares for us. What factors have you found can influence you to not seek counsel? What things help you to readily receive godly counsel from others?
2. Caring for others through counsel involves compassion, humility, empathy, listening, and patience; asking questions with understanding, having discernment, and speaking with wisdom. As a caregiver who gives counsel, which characteristics play to your strengths, and where might you need to grow?
