Proverbs 5

1. Almost everything today is sexualized throughout the fabric of our culture. What did you grow up hearing, learning and believing about sex that you now understand are lies?
2. The sexual union between a man and woman is intended only for marriage and is sacred because marriage is sacred. Marriage and sex are powerful metaphors of the union that exists between Christ and the Church, intended to point to the deeper reality of the gospel. What comes to mind when considering how sex can practically reflect the gospel?
3. Sexual sin offers false promises that only leave us dissatisfied and thirstier, with bitter, unexpected consequences. How are you growing in wisdom to actively guard your heart and mind from the immediate temptations of sexual sin? What measures are you taking to protect yourself from being led astray?
