Got Wisdom: Wisdom and Money – Proverbs 30:7-9

1. How has money influenced and affected your life? What has been your experience between the two poles of poverty and riches?
2. How we understand and view wealth is an indicator of how we will respond to situations involving the need for and pursuit of money. Our heart's attitude in the way we view wealth and respond to both material hardships and blessing matters to God. What insights shared in this message helped, encouraged or convicted you as regards your outlook on poverty and riches?
3. The book of Proverbs doesn't advocate for the pursuit of material wealth, but rather, surrounds the realities of wealth and its proper stewardship with warnings and admonitions. For those seeking to live wisely, the great priority of life is not a matter of money and prosperity but is about being true to God. Proverbs is filled with encouragements to make every sacrifice in order to be wise, to fear the Lord and pursue righteousness. What comes to mind when you consider the spiritual wealth you have in knowing God and being in Christ, and how does that knowledge relate to the status of your material wealth?
