What the Savior Sees – Luke 15:1-7

1. What kinds of situations with unbelievers do you tend to engage, and which ones do you more often draw away from? Why do you think this is the case?
2. When sharing the gospel with others, what comes easy for you? What aspects of sharing Christ do you find difficult? What kinds of people are you most drawn to in sharing your faith?
3. In his sovereignty, God has perfectly placed us exactly where he wants us, to connect with lost people who need to hear the gospel. How has this sermon helped you to more faithfully and intentionally move towards specific unbelievers whom God has planted you near?
4. Angels in heaven have the great privilege of seeing and experiencing Christ joyfully rejoicing over sinners who repent and trust in him. The Lord not only rejoices when people are saved, but that he also took joy in sacrificing his life so that we could be rescued from danger. He does this because he loves and values us. Pray that God would cultivate in you a deeper compassion for the lost and increase your motivation to sacrifice and take risks in order to share the gospel with them.
