Everyday Series: Death

Main Point: The reality of death helps us cherish life and die with meaning.

Application Points:

1. Death is an inescapable fact.
2. Death is a troubling fact.
3. Death is a clarifying fact.
4. Death is not the final fact.

Application Questions:

1. When did you first face the reality of death? How did that experience affect you?
2. Have you ever felt as if “good things seem to happen to unbelievers” and “bad things seem to happen to Christians”? If so, why might we be prone to evaluate God’s love for us by our circumstances? How should we understand God’s love?
3. How do you feel about the thought of being forgotten after you die? If our legacy will not last, what ultimately brings meaning to the things we do in life?
4. How can contemplating death be an encouragement to enjoy life and live it in a meaningful way?
